#### A statement from Head of English Department



The vision of the English Department is based on excellence in teaching English language and literature. In order to achieve this vision, the course plan of the department comprises several areas in literature and linguistics. In literature, courses such as novel, poetry, and literary criticism are offered. Linguistics comprises two main branches: theoretical and applied. In the theoretical branch, the student takes courses such as phonetics, phonology, syntax, and semantics. These courses contribute to the development of the learner's linguistic knowledge. Applied linguistics is primarily concerned with the application of linguistic theories, methods, and findings to elucidate language-based problems. Teaching students such theories, therefore, not only helps them solve learning problems but also makes them aware of practical aspects and activities of language learning they need in classrooms.

The course plan also includes courses dealing with the teaching of basic skills: reading, listening, speaking and writing, and some important related materials such as vocabulary building, grammar, and translation.

This diversity in the study plan is specifically intended to provide students with basic qualifications in the field of English language. Therefore, a student with a bachelor's degree from the Department of English can pursue graduate studies in one of these fields or join the job market directly with all its opportunities, whether in education, translation or any other field requiring proficiency in English.

#### **Brief History of The English Department**



The College was established in 1429H by a Royal Decree on 1428/11/21 to offer bachelor degrees in all departments to contribute actively for the promotion and interaction with the community. The College is equipped with qualified staff to achieve the required objectives.

The Royal Decree was issued on 1432/11/18 to rename the College of Sciences in Aldawadmi as College of Sciences and Humanities and to establish four new departments:

Business Administration, Law, Accounting, and English.

The English Language Department is located in the main campus of the College of Sciences and Humanities in Dawadmi. It offers a program in English Language and Literature for both male and female students, in the main campus, as well as two other branches in the cities of Al Bijadyah and Aljamsh for female students.
