## **Course Description**

This course provides an understanding of the nurse's role in health and illness within evolving practice environments and across the spectrum of health and illness. This course will address nursing care issues among adult clients from a physiologic, pathophysiologic, and psychosocial context. The course focuses on pathophysiology, risk factors, clinical manifestations, assessment and diagnostic findings, complications, and medical and nursing management of various disorders of gas exchange and respiratory function, cardiovascular and circulatory function, hematologic function, digestive and gastrointestinal function, and metabolic and endocrine function. The course also addresses the concepts and challenges in patient management including fluids and electrolytes balance and disturbances, as well as the perioperative concepts and nursing management.
